Wedac may be applied by tank immersion, circulation, brush or wipe-on methods.

Concentration

5-25% by volume with water.

**Temperature** 

160-180°F.

Rinsing

After cleaning, always rinse with water. At high temperatures solutions are low foaming, facilitating rinsing.

**Wedac** solutions are not recommended for cleaning galvanized, chrome, nickel or tin plated metals.

# **FIRST AID MEASURES**
